Bryn Manor, Llanfyllin, Powys Sleeps 14

What Georgian Manor perched on a small hilltop in the rolling countryside of the Welsh Marches. Good for parties with an aversion to cooking: your host, Lady Linlithgow, has her family cook on hand.

Activities Pheasant-shooting (100- to 200-bird days available at extra cost).

Tennis, fishing, clay-pigeon shooting, archery, hiking, riding, historic house and garden visits.

Small downside The no-pets, no-children rule

Tipperary, the Lizard Peninsula, Cornwall Sleeps 8

What A modern house with 180-degree views of the coast. The property, in 22 acres, has a snug “for children to escape the adults”.

A chef can be booked in advance if required, at additional cost. Festive welcome hamper with a half case of wine and locally made pasties awaits. And there’s a Cornish cream tea on arrival.

Activities This is a house for surfers – recommended beaches include Poldhu and Gunwalloe, both 30 minutes away. Nearer, but for hardy swimmers, is Kynance Cove (two miles). The South West Coast Path runs along the end of the property’s garden, and heading west for five miles along the cliff top and rugged headlands you reach the Lizard lighthouse, the most southerly point in England and very bracing in January with gale force south westerlies.

Alexander House, Thorpeness, Suffolk Sleeps 11

What Secluded, traditional Suffolk farmhouse, probably dating back to the 16th century, now restored to provide spacious and comfortable accommodation. Surrounded by a secluded, lawned garden and acres of fields and heathland, one can enjoy all the pleasures of a seaside holiday as the beach is a two-minute walk away.

Activities Trekking from the stables (about a mile away) across lowland heaths and the beach. Golf course is on the doorstep (about a three-minute walk). Bird watching (the heath is an RSPB site), cycling and walking from the house.

Sleeps 10 to 12

What A house for anyone looking for total privacy and remoteness – it is accessed via its own private, five-mile, unmade road.

Activities Hind-stalking £150+VAT per rifle per day; walked-up ptarmigan £500+VAT per day (four to six guns); woodcock and driven shooting can be arranged nearby.

Numerous hill lochs and a waterfall walk within two miles of the house.

Halzephron House, Gunwalloe, Cornwall

Sleeps up to 16 (2 on a sofa bed)

Property Halzephron House

What A cosy, 17th-century castellated property high on the Cornish cliffs, surrounded by open National Trust land, with stunning sea views.

Activities Surfers can head to the beach at Church Cove, a 10-minute walk down the lane, or Poldhu Cove, an additional 10 minutes across the golf course. The Halzephron Inn, a five-minute walk in the opposite direction, was named Cornwall Dining Pub of the Year 2005. If you want to eat in but without hassle, catering can be arranged at extra cost. There is a large, sheltered, walled garden with palm trees and lawns at the front looking across Mount's Bay. The garden boasts a games pitch, inset trampoline and half-pipe skateboard ramp which may be shared with the owner's children. The spot is excellent for twitchers.

Old Light, Lundy Island, North Devon

Sleeps 4 and 5

What Something rather different: two lighthouse keepers' cottages in the Old Light on Lundy Island. Basic, potentially blustery, potentially very romantic.

Activities Quite a DIY set-up: walking

around the island, bird watching and seal watching.

The Old Rectory, Bratoff, nr Skegness, Lincs

Sleeps 11



What Elegant, late 18th-century Regency rectory built from local redbrick, set in a large garden with open views and lying close to the tiny church of Bratoff village.

Activities Sited at the edge of the Lincolnshire Wolds, an area of outstanding beauty, this is a house for groups partial to house snooping. It provides an excellent base from which to visit National Trust properties Gunby Hall, Tattershall Castle and Belton House, as well as picture-postcard villages and the market towns of Spilsby, Tattershall and Coningsby.

Knock House, Benmore estate, Isle of Mull Sleeps up to 22

What Estate extends to 17,000 acres and Knock House is a very comfortable family home situated at the head of Loch Na Keal.

Activities Benmore is a famous deer forest with some of the finest stalking grounds in Argyll. Informal walked-up shooting can be arranged over Christmas. The estate has three sea boats, including a Rib speed-boat, an Orkney fishing boat and a 32ft motor cruiser – brilliant for trips to the islands and picnics. Also available: tennis, crabbing, riding, whale watching and clay-pigeon shooting. The island is a great place to see eagles and other birds of prey, such as the peregrine falcon and the hen harrier. And you may spot a short-eared owl if you're lucky.

Carreglwyd, Nr Holyhead Anglesey North Wales Sleeps 12 plus additional cottage for 2 by arrangement

Activities A place that caters for all tastes. Excellent walking from the doorstep as the estate joins the Anglesey Coastal Path, which goes round almost all the island. There is a commercial shoot on the estate for duck and partridges, and clays can be arranged. Coarse-fishing for carp and perch is possible on the lake in front of the house. Riding can be arranged on the estate and bicycles hired locally. The beach is 15 minutes on foot through the estate, and there is a surfing beach about 20 minutes' drive away. Good twitching as a number of seabirds overwinter in Anglesey. Nearby are the castles of Caernarfon and Harlech.

What Large private home with log fire and underfloor heating, set in 20 acres in the Exe valley.

Activities Private half-mile beat on the Exe, complete with fishing hut and seven named pools. Grayling up to 15in long can be caught over the Christmas period. Other activities

include bird watching in the copses and on the water meadows, game- or rough-shooting, foxhunting with the Lamerton or staghunting with the Tiverton.

Up to 36 can eat together, with a chef available to cook if preferred. The houses will be decorated for Christmas; home-made mince pies and wine will await arrivals.

One guest has written in the logbook: "I would like to spend all night out on the battlements watching the stars." Perhaps not ideal in December, but what a good spot from which to view any New Year fireworks.

Activities Kayaking from the private rocks below the castle or walking (15 minutes) to Kingswear for sailing

What A family home situated on a 9,000-acre estate on the Speyside Malt Whisky Distillery Trail

Activities Shooting (grouse, pheasants, roe deer) and some rough-shooting can be arranged on nearby estates. Beyond the estate walls there's the chance to spot dolphins, play golf, ski or visit Cawdor Castle and Gardens. On seriously rainy days, you can play tennis and football in the indoor sports hall.
