19. Millook beach hut

Anyone who has taken the rollercoaster Marine Drive from Widemouth Bay to Crackington Haven will have seen the wooden shack just after the bridge in Millook and wondered whether it is for sale – it's not, because it's one of the biggest rental earners on the Cornish coast. A former tearoom turned love shack with a log burner, next to a rocky beach popular only with the odd surfer who comes to ride Millook's left-hand point break, the Beach Hut gets booked up months in advance. So if you want it, book now, and if you get it, go with supplies because it's rather remote. Sleeps two.
