## THE FABLE, Perranporth

The exterior of this 18th-century thatched cob cottage may be a delicate pink, but inside the theme is definitely white. The White Company – stalwart of all that is tranquil and serene – was invited by Unique Homestays to decorate the newly renovated cottage. Everything from the bed linen to the tableware, fluffy robes to cashmere throws, has been curated by The White Company to create the ultimate home-to-dream-home atmosphere. Rustic furniture and wonky walls stop it all looking too pristine, so you can truly relax after a day exploring the North Cornwall coast.

Because, while the cottage is idyllic, it's the setting that seals the deal – the rugged beaches and sweeping coastline of Perranporth and Hollywell Bay are 10 minutes away, where you'll find sandy beaches and dusky dunes, rockpools and a natural swimming pool carved into the landscape. This is *Poldark* country, so you can follow in the footsteps of Ross and Demelza, before heading to Newquay for supper at The Fish House (and maybe a tipple from Healeys Cyder Farm). Back at the cottage, there's a hot tub to slip into – or perhaps enjoy a nightcap in the summerhouse.
