The Slim-Aarons-esque pool is long enough to get some real mileage (or at least metreage) under your belt, and you can call in at-home spa treatments to have in the pool house. Speaking of which, the outer building comes with an impressive sauna and sizeable steam room, with a classy wooden hot tub outside near the pizza oven – the recipe for an unforgettable summer's night.
