

5. Ukiyo, Cornwall

With views of Coverack Cove and a vast stretch of blue-green sea, Ukiyo's setting is unmistakably Cornish. Its style, however, draws on a range of influences: well-mannered Japanese simplicity paired with silvery larchwood from Siberia, and a clifftop terrace straight out of Greece.
