## TRIED AND TESTED BEACH HOUSE RENTALS IN THE UK

## BAY VIEW COTTAGE, WHITBY, YORKSHIRE (VIA UNIQUE HOMESTAYS)

Stuffed with board games and books, Bay View makes a brilliant hideout all year round, so don't just bookmark it for summer. Between the heather-topped moorland and the wild North Sea, the cottage overlooks Robin Hood's Bay – whose name remains a bit of a mystery, even to local historians – in the seaside town of Whitby. With its slick underfloor heating, mezzanine bedroom and velvety interiors, you'd never know this building was originally a stable block. Nowadays, you're unlikely to come across any equine animals, but there are deer, badgers, pheasants, rabbits and partridges to spot nearby. We like that owners Dawn and Steven provide Martini glasses and bathrobes – these are people who understand how to take a proper break.

## THE SHIPWRECK, WHITSAND BAY, CORNWALL (VIA UNIQUE HOMESTAYS)

The Shipwreck is both named after and built using materials scavenged from Kodima, a vessel that ran aground in Whitsand Bay in 2002. Its white cladding walls and wooden shutters are typically Cornish, but the vistas of Portwrinkle Beach are anything but commonplace. While there's plenty to keep you busy in this south-east corner of Cornwall – try rock pooling, surfing, or paddleboarding – there's only so much you can be expected to do when there's a chrome bathtub with ocean views, and we won't judge if that's the closest you get to a swim. The Shipwreck is so near the beach it feels like private access, and Unique Homestays offers add-on packages such as dining experiences by chef Anna Humphreys to make your visit extra special.

## SEREN MOR, PEMBROKESHIRE, WALES (VIA UNIQUE HOMESTAYS)

Not only is it ideally located for exploring the <a href="Pembrokeshire">Pembrokeshire</a> Coast
National Park, but glass-fronted Seren Mor provides a sweeping panoramic view of Newport's paint-by-numbers estuary. The house's name translates as 'star of the sea', and with showstopping views from the timber-decked balcony and wildflower-filled garden, it's easy to see why. The upside-down RIBA award-winning property was designed by architect firm John Pardey, with the open-plan living room and kitchen on the upper level to make the most of the views. If you can't get enough, walk the three miles to the top of craggy Carningli Mountain for more. The Chattocks, who own the place, also allow guest access to kayaks, kids' wetsuits, a boules set, a barbecue and a secret pathway to the beach.
