4. Tincture, Powys

This ancient farmhouse, just upgraded and open for bookings, stands beyond the town of Llanwrtyd Wells — handy for the Brecon Beacons and Cambrian Mountains. The renovation is as slick as it is sustainable: local stone and slate were used, and breathable, non-chemical paints applied in soothing milky tones. You're completely off-grid, which means heating via a Rayburn, electricity from solar panels and water from a spring. The setting is tranquil, too, surrounded by moorlands, conifer forests and little else.
