Kick off 2023 in style at one of these fabulous stays big enough for family and friends

3. Benetfeld, Berkshire

Anyone with a penchant for the conventionally unconventional will love this beefy, grade II listed, red-brick stately home, built in 1775 by the gloriously named Onesiphorus Elliot. Inside, the artistic inclinations of the current owners are unshackled from any 18th-century constraints, with pop art, decorative electric guitars and modish furnishings reflecting well-travelled lives. There's a ballroom, of course, and the light-filled kitchen is in the orangery. Outside, beyond the estate's soaring cedars and ancient oaks, Royal Windsor is almost within shouting distance. (Guests have the central section of the house; its wings are otherwise occupied.)
